

LC06-22 Maternity Healthy Weight Additional Information

1. What discussions have taken place with GM around future opportunities if this is successful? (e.g. potential options for Business Case if the trial is a success)

During development of the bid, links have been made with Greater Manchester (GM) through the children's and maternity leads engaged in the GM integration pilot and future commissioning options have been explored as part of this work stream. Salford commissioning leads also planned to present the pilot at the GM children's and maternity consortium, however the meeting was stood down whilst awaiting further governance guidance from the ICB.

Going forward, should the pilot be successful, there is also the potential to explore the following options:

1. *Development of business case with the 5 localities (previously CCGs) that hold the current weight management contract to implement the new maternity model. Salford are the commissioning lead for this contract and have considered how a business case could be progressed across the 5 localities. This option would require each locality to approve through their own local governance routes.*
2. *There is potential for commissioning opportunities through the new NHS Integrated Care structure. It is still too early to fully understand what this structure will look like but hopefully this will become clearer over the course of the pilot.*
3. *There has been engagement with two NHS providers (Manchester Foundation Trust and Bolton Foundation Trust) in the development and roll out of the pilot which will potentially support the awareness of the offer within other localities and support uptake going forward.*
4. *The evaluation of the pilot will be fed back through the national pilot governance which could see additional funds secured to implement the suggested model.*
